It has been awhile between centre titles this past season, the last one being the BNH Power Play League and just prior to that Birkenhead's Daymon Pierson had paired up with Orewa's Christeen Dalzell to claim the BNH Mixed 242 Pairs. The Champ of Champ Triples looked promising with Birkenhead's Milika Nathan, Amy Little and Ruth Lynch (s) back to defend the women's title they won last season. The Men's and Birkenhead's hopes were on Jimmy Heath, Jack Huriwai and Steve Yates (s).

The women had an early departure going down to Mahurangi East (13-18).

The Men hung around for a little longer winning their first round (15-3) over Miarangi's Ian Coombe triple. Quarters and a closer encounter against Gordon Smith's Riverhead trio with Birkenhead advancing to the semi-final (15-13).

All that stood in Yates's way of a finals birth was Milford. As it turned out it was a comfortable win to Yates and co (27-3). The final against Helensville's Kylie Clark, Mark Preedy and Ricky Howe saw Birkenhead trailing for much of the game (7-10, 8-12, 12-13), but a late rally saw Yates's trio pull ahead (15-13) and held a six shot lead going into the last (19-13). Two shots to Yates on the last sealed the win and the title (21-13).

Yates's first Harbour title, but the third for each of Heath and Huriwai.

Nice to have a bit more silverware in the trophy cabinet at Birkenhead..... Thanks lads. Next step is chasing some national glory as the lads move onto Bowls New Zealand's Champion of Champions Triples to be held at Bowls Hastings in the Hawkes Bay, Friday 16 July to Sunday 18 July.

Look at them.


Together they stand on the hill telling each other stories and feeling the warmth of the sun on their backs.


