Our Matriarch Now a Legend

She was our Matriarch and at the 20th Anniversary Bowls North Harbour Awards Ceremony, held at Birkenhead last Sunday afternoon, Carole Fredrick was honoured with being inducted a Legend of Bowls North Harbour. Carole's three children Mark, Lee, Paul and their families along with bowling buddy Ruth Lynch where all present to see the honour bestowed on Carole, with Mark accepting the award on behalf of his late mum.

Birkenhead's Gary Stevens addressed the 140+ attendees present, outlining Carole's extensive bowling achievements.

It's a real privilege to read this citation for Carole Fredrick who is today being inducted as a Legend of Bowls North Harbour – special recognition for those people who have an outstanding record in the playing of our favourite sport.

And how appropriate that this is happening at Birkenhead Club, her home club during her later years. Our members remember her with real fondness.

I also want to welcome Carole's family to our ceremony today as we recognise her for her achievements.

Carole was one North Harbour's most illustrious women's bowlers who was widely respected throughout Bowls North Harbour and elsewhere in New Zealand.

Originally from Wellington, she started bowling with her husband, Noel, also a competent player and sound administrator, at the Titahi Bay club in 1973.

But it was on the North Shore where she achieved most of her bowling success. Firstly, as part of the old Waitemata Women's Centre and then with what eventually became Bowls North Harbour. Carole first played in North Harbour at the Stanley Club. She then joined Sunnybrae, Glenfield and finally for many seasons, she played at Birkenhead.

In all, she won 27 centre titles (25 in North Harbour), two National Fours titles and two Taranaki Fours – itself recognised as a prestigious feat. In her teenage years Carole played representative cricket and netball and her sporting pedigree included a father, Eddie Barton, who played association football for New Zealand, and an older brother, Paul Barton, who was a lovely test batsman for New Zealand cricket sides in the 1960s.

Among Paul's deeds was a test century against South Africa in 1961-62 when New Zealand toured that country under the captaincy of John Reid.

Little wonder, with such a sporting background that Carole soon established herself as an accomplished bowler, who went on to win those 27 centre titles, two national titles and two Taranaki fours.

Her first national title came in 1999 in the Fours when she was in a Harbour composite team skipped by the great Marlene Castle (herself, a Legend of Bowls North Harbour) and which also included a close friend, and another well-performed Harbour identity, Mary Guldbrandsen, as well as Paulette Mytton.

But her most satisfying feat came with her second Fours national success with her close friend, Ruth Lynch, Gayle Melrose and Lisa Helming.

This was in 2012 and it was especially precious for Carole in that it was achieved by a team of members from the Birkenhead Club in an age dominated by "dream teams" composed of players from different clubs.

Noel, who pre-deceased her by some years, was ailing at the time and Carole dedicated the win to him.

Ruth Lynch, another with many Bowls North Harbour titles, many of them won with Carole, has recalled her bowling buddy with unqualified affection.

While they had many wins together, they were not what Ruth has treasured most from her friendship with Carole. "What I cherish most is that we played for fun and what I remember most is the laughs we had together," she says.

And isn't that what bowls is all about?

Though highly competitive, Carole was always a gracious opponent. She continued to play into her final years, passing away aged 80 in January 2020.

Truly Carole Fredrick deserves the honour of being a Legend of Bowls North Harbour.

Other Bowls North Harbour identities to be inducted Legend of Bowls North Harbour at the Awards were Brent Turner and Ivan Kostanich.

The demolition costs are to be increased by \$50,000 alone. Apparently building costs have increased significantly, particularly over the last twelve months.

Birkenhead Bowling Club has been fortunate over recent years to have had some quality patrons. Bill Plunket served the Club well right up until his passing. Shane Prince took over from Bill Plunket and has certainly gone beyond the call to support the Club in many aspects. More recently Jonathan Coleman up until the AGM where work commitments have forced him to relinquish the position. As a result at AGM 2021 Pete Taylor was recommended by the Board of Management and accepted by the members present to join Shane Prince as one of the two Club Patrons. So who are Shane Prince and Pete Taylor?

Born and raised in sunny Napier, Shane grew up around cars and followed his passion of cars into the Automotive industry, working for automotive repairers, parts supply companies and in 1994 being drawn into the car auction industry, accepting a role with Turners Group NZ Limited (formally Turners Auctions)

Outside these two organisation's you often see Shane volunteering in the community as a master of ceremonies at functions or being an Auctioneer raising money for charities. Shane is married to Karen and they have two children Brandon who has followed his Fathers steps joining Fire and Emergency as a volunteer and a daughter Nicole who is currently studying communications at University.
