With qualifying games truncated to 11 ends due to concerns over Saturday's uncertain weather section qualifying was a sprint. Birkenhead's men didn't fire and all were available for alternative tournaments the following day. The Women and highly fancied Milika Nathan lost her first to Takapuna's Irene Costello (9-12), won her second courtesy of a bye and the third game was a dead rubber as Costello had two wins and the bye in game three. Birkenhead's other woman representative was Judi Farkash. A win courtesy of a bye, a draw in the second (8-8) and a win in the third (10-9) was enough for Farkash to make post section Sunday.

Sunday dawned, the semi-finals and now first to 21 shots, Farkash up against Belmont Parks Maxe Janssen with Farkash coming away the winner (21-13) and into the final. Having initially missed the deadline for applications was the only nomination from the floor for the vacant position of President. Joseph Korkis unopposed returns for a second term as Vice President. Terry Moverley returns for an eighth term as Secretary, while Elaine Utting QSM also returns for a third term in the position of Treasurer. 
