

Covid 19 Policy

PREAMBLE:

The Birkenhead Bowling Club Board have met to discuss how the Club goes forward in light of recent Government announcements.

The Board is committed to protecting our members, contractors and any visitors to our Club from the harmful effects of COVID-19, as well as minimising the risk of COVID-19 transmission within both the Bowling community and the wider community. In this regard, we are following the lead of Bowls New Zealand and Bowls North Harbour who have both advised that double vaccine is now a requirement for players and Clubs they will use for their own tournaments.

We also believe that this is necessary to ensure the sustainability and financial viability of the Club. It has therefore been decided to implement the following policy: **POLICY STATEMENT**:

That the Birkenhead Bowling Club will mandate the requirement for a Covid19 Vaccination Certificate to be provided to the Club prior to individuals entering Birkenhead Bowling Club premises. This will come into effect as soon as the Government provide the means to enforce the policy.

This policy will cover playing members, social members, visitors, employees, contractors, suppliers and any person entering the Club property.

This decision is based on the current information available. The Board will monitor the situation and may make changes to this policy if Government legislation requires it.

The change in alert level today brings good news for retailers, as stores around the city are allowed to open their doors again after 84 days of being in a strict lockdown - and just weeks away from the all-important Christmas shopping season.

Public facilities including libraries, museums and the zoo will also open - albeit with visitors having to wear masks and keeping two metres apart at all times.

The 10-people picnics will be expanded to allow for 25 people at outdoor gatherings and there will no longer be a restriction on the number of households represented in those gatherings.

But hospitality remains closed and organised events on the Club's green is still a no go. The greens remain open for practice, while you can now use the toilet in the shed. The clubrooms remain closed.

Step 2 on Greens

Step Two: Under this step, the Bowls New Zealand recommendations are the following changes:

- Gatherings (not events) of no more than 25 persons may take place on the green.
- There are no restrictions on the number of bubbles that may mix.
 - Bowlers may switch rinks.

BNH Changes to Playing Programme

The Match Committee (MC) of Bowls North Harbour has been further considering the ongoing challenges being caused by the lock down and the inability of being able to get the season underway. This has had severe disruptions to both the Centre and club programmes and the result of this is a material impact on the financial outcome it has to both clubs and the Centre in order to survive the current crisis.

Therefore the MC has given further consideration to the re-scheduling of the Centre events and in the process tried to minimise the interference to club programmes. The MC has now decided to manipulate around dates on which the Centre events had already been scheduled.

Bowls North Harbour now advise clubs of the following changes to the Centre programme for this season -
