Covid 19 Policy

POLICY STATEMENT:

That the Birkenhead Bowling Club will mandate the requirement for a Covid19 Vaccination Certificate to be provided to the Club prior to individuals entering Birkenhead Bowling Club premises. This will come into effect as soon as the Government provide the means to enforce the policy.

This policy will cover playing members, social members, visitors, employees, contractors, suppliers and any person entering the Club property.

This decision is based on the current information available. The Board will monitor the situation and may make changes to this policy if Government legislation requires it.

Clubrooms reopen 3.30pm Friday 3 December

Red Traffic Light restrictions apply

Double Vax Required

We are preparing to reopen 3.30pm Friday 3 December under the government's RED Traffic Light. With various limitations on operating, one being My Vaccine Pass will be required, with entry and exit to the Clubrooms and greens only available via the Clubrooms main entrance.

My Vaccine Pass is an official record of a person's COVID-19 vaccination status and will provide access to places within New Zealand that require proof of vaccination under the new COVID-19 Protection Framework, the Birkenhead Bowling Club is one such place. It is your official proof of vaccination and a ticket to enjoy the Club's facilities that will come with the COVID-19 Protection Framework. To get one, people will need to be fully vaccinated or be one of the very small number of Kiwis who has received a medical exemption

The My Vaccine Pass is issued by the Ministry of Health and can be obtained by logging onto My COVID Record to make a request for the free pass or call 0800 222 478. My Vaccine Pass has a QR code that can be scanned upon arrival at the Club. The pass can be downloaded to your personal phone and stored in your Apple or Google Wallet, or may be printed out.

Anyone entering or on the Club's premises may be requested by a Board of Management member to provide proof of the government's My Vaccine Pass, failure to comply will require the person to leave the Club's premises immediately.



Step 2 on Greens

To all Full Members, an update for the use of the greens as interpreted by Bowls New Zealand. Our club will have the following temporary changes. Please contact either Joe (0212635606) or Doug (0223580878) if you want to have a practice

Step Two: Under this step, the Bowls New Zealand recommendations are the following changes:

- Gatherings (not events) of no more than 25 persons may take place on the green.
- There are no restrictions on the number of bubbles that may mix.
- Bowlers may switch rinks.
- Shed will be open only for essential services (e.g. toilets)
- The wearing of face coverings is encouraged. If teams of pairs or triples wish to organise a game between themselves, they are free to do so.
- Jacks and mats must please be sanitised.
- Practice will be on Tuesday to Saturday between 11am to 5pm.

The last person to leave must lock the gate, day and night.

December Quiz Night is scheduled for Tuesday 9, while Housie is Tuesday 16. The full extent of restrictions under the government's RED Traffic Light is still unknown. If we are able to return safely to running these in December we will, but we await further clarification.

Bowls New Zealand would like to acknowledge the Auckland, Counties Manukau and North Harbour bowling clubs that have been impacted by Auckland's lockdown these past three months. It has been a long and frustrating 14+ weeks for we Aucklanders.

The impact on many bowling clubs in the Auckland region has been significant, with a

The impact on many bowling clubs in the Auckland region has been significant, with a number of clubs missing out on key annual revenue from members and the casual bowls market (especially Xmas corporate).

All bowling clubs in the Auckland region should have considered the support packages available through:

- Aktive Auckland sports club support
- IRD Resurgent Support payments

Some clubs may also have accessed the Government's wage subsidy scheme. To further support bowling clubs in the Auckland region, the Board of Bowls New Zealand will be issuing a credit note for 25% of each bowling club's 2021 affiliation fees. The credit

note will be issued within the next ten days and only applies to Auckland, North Harbour and Counties Manukau bowling clubs. Those clubs that have already paid their affiliation fees will receive a credit to their bank account.

In addition, the Board of Bowls New Zealand has established a small Hardship Fund, to assist any bowling club that is in danger of collapsing due to the impact of the current COVID-19 lockdown for the Auckland region. To access this fund, please contact us directly - we will be requiring evidence of your current financial position.

n.b. The above support will come from Bowls New Zealand reserves. Unfortunately Bowls New Zealand is not able to access any of the government schemes including the wage subsidy or resurgent support payments, as we do not meet the criteria.

On behalf of the Board and staff of Bowls New Zealand, our thanks to each of your clubs for your support over the past three months. There now appears to be some light at the end of the tunnel and we remain optimistic that on the 29th November, the Government will announce Aucklanders will again be able to go about their 'normal' summer activities, including playing bowls.

- 3. Click on <u>Visit my covid record</u> to request your pass which will take you to a page which looks like this.




- 4. Click log in or sign up to create a "My Health Account". You will need an email address to be able to sign up <u>OR</u> a RealMe account. If you will be using your email address to register you will need either a driver's license, passport or birth certificate to register.
- 5. If you have none of these documents then you can call <u>0800 222 478</u> with your NHI number ready.
