

Trophy of Friendship

First played 17/12/1966

Published in "Times" 12/01/1967

The first annual competition for a trophy known as the Christmas Shield, was played for between teams representing the Northcote and Birkenhead bowling clubs. Both clubs had two wins but Northcote took the Shield by 104 points to 74. Donor of the shield, Mr Denis Hudson of Northcote, said he had donated the shield in recognition of the goodwill which existed between the two clubs. Mr Fred Claxton (Birkenhead) and Mr Don Lawson (Northcote) spoke in similar fashion. Results (Northcote names first):


