She beat another strong player in the semi-final, Takapuna's Skye Renes, 20-13, having beaten the same player in post-section in the senior championship seven days earlier. Farkash performed well to make the final and was a decisive 21-9 winner in the semi-final over Helensville's Sharon Parker.



Having been part of the Birkenhead playing calendar for around twenty years the annual Seafood Tournament is certainly a highlight of each season. Originally a two-day men's fours the change in recent years to any combination has ensured its survival. This year's tournament was full early with thirty-two teams but then the covid restrictions kicked in and along with some teams being covid shy the numbers dropped and were eventually capped at twenty-four teams and even then, the twenty fourth spot team changed repeatedly before Randall Watkins secured the last spot available.

The tournament has only had a couple of sponsors over the years, Ra Te Amo for much of that and Wheels on Wairau, thanks to Graeme Rutherford, these last few years and this season we welcomed Summerset at Monterey Park for the first time.

Saturday 2 April arrived, and Sandy Cleghorn dressed in his Club blazer got the tournament underway, everyone poured out onto the green and settled into two days of bowls, eating seafood, drinking, seafood raffles and just having a good time. The weather couldn't have been any better and as for the greens, if you like a quick green last weekend was the time to be on Birkenhead's, green keeper Brendon Kelly had both running superbly. By the time Sunday afternoon arrived and seven games had been played and all players had been sufficiently feed and watered over the two days it was down to the prizegiving. Prizes all seafood were given out with Tony Grantham's four taking out first prize with an unbeaten weekend of seven wins. Beach Haven's Roy Parkers four with six wins claimed second spot. Parkers only loss was to Lionel Drew's team who went onto secure third spot with five wins and a draw. Of the five winners it was John Hindmarch's four with fortysix ends claiming fourth spot, nudging out Evan Thomas by five ends, Ruth Lynch by twelve ends and Jack Huriwai by fourteen ends.


