

In the first four games (reverse pairs), Alex (Fighting Rabbit) was paired with Glenn (Double 'Ard) and Willie (The Conqueror) was paired with Bryce (The Thumb). Both pairings won both games with Alex & Glenn winning 2-1, 2-1 and Willie and Bryce winning both games 2-0, 2-0. Getting those four points gave the guy's huge momentum heading into the singles.

The star of the singles was Glenn – winning all four of his games and not dropping a single leg – awesome darts! (2-0 x 4). Willie won an impressive 3 out of 4 (2-0, 2-1, 2-0, 0-2). Bryce and Alex won two out of four (0-2, 2-1, 1-2, 2-1 and 1-2, 1-2, 2-0, 2-1 respectively. Bryce was The Stinger that hit a 180 in only his second game of the season – nice one The Thumb. Alex still leads the way this season with 2 180's.

Scoring machine of the day was Bryce with eleven 100 plus scores including his 180, two 140s and two 100 plus starts. Next in line was Willie with eight 100 plus scores including a 140 and 105 start. Glenn grabbed seven and Alex bagged six.

Score of the day must go to Alex for hitting an impressive 111 score whilst at the same time leaving a not-so-easy finish of 5!
