

AGM 2022

AGM 2022 rolled around last Sunday morning. There had been a bit of talk and lobbying in resent weeks as there were a number of members vying for the positions of President, Vice President and one of five Board Member positions. Joseph Korkis moved from Vice President last year to President having won the race over two others, while previous Board Member Doug Campbell was elected Vice President.

Terry Moverley returns for a ninth term as Secretary, while Elaine Utting QSM also returns for her fourth term in the position of Treasurer.

Incumbents Keith Burgess, Evan Thomas and Emmie Swart all return to the Board, Swart subsequently being elected Chairperson for another year.

Making up the remaining two spots on the Board are new comers Barry Reyland and Curtis Ennor.

The subs for 2022-23 remain unchanged as per 2021-22.

The only remit submitted was one removing the use of Clearance Certificates from the Club's Constitution. This is in line with Bowls New Zealand removing it from their Constitution and Bowls North Harbour intending to do the same.

Terry Moverley was honoured for his years of service to the Club with the Club Excellence Award. Moverley said after the AGM "you don't do the job for the accolades, you do it for the betterment of the Club and members".



Terry Achieves Club Excellence Award

At the Club's AGM on Sunday 12th June, Terry Moverley was awarded the Club's Excellence Award. This was to recognise the efforts Terry has made over several years, in not just performing his Club secretary duties, but also the additional things Terry has instigated to make the Club what it is today. Terry has in the past been awarded Bowls North

Harbour 'Administrator of the Year Award' on two occasions, and also been a finalist in the same category of the Bowls New Zealand award. It was time to have Terry recognised within his own club of the efforts he has made over time.

Some of the notable things Terry has instigated within the club include -

- Club improvements for the enjoyment of members, such as additional TV screens (including the purchase of a wide screen TV for viewing of televised sports), enhanced club lighting, WIFI services, modern audio system, and security cameras.
- Compilation and issue of the weekly 'Bee Express', which commenced publication in 2014.
- In 2019 was co-opted by Bowls North Harbour to help co-ordinate the inaugural Masters tournament held in 2020 – 2021 season, with Birkenhead the tournament host club.


