

Note: Players must have paid their Birkenhead 2022-23 playing membership subscription in full to be eligible to play BNH PPL.





Investing in our local community since 1967...

The Birkenhead Licensing Trust was established in 1967 to operate on and off licences for the sale of alcohol in the old Birkenhead Borough Council area.

The Trust currently owns two bars: The Good Home in Birkenhead and the Inn Field in Glenfield.

The profits from these two bars and the net proceeds from the Lion Foundation pokie machines located in each bar, are distributed each year to community groups in the Trust's local area. In 2018 the Trust distributed close to \$1,800,000 to groups in the Birkdale, Beachhaven, Birkenhead, Glenfield and Northcote.

The Trust has six elected trustees (Stuart

The trustees are elected at the same time as the Auckland Council local body elections. The trustee's role is to oversee the businesses and to consider and approve grants to local community groups.
