Conditions at Manly were gusty and had frustrated many of the bowlers across the two greens, making it difficult to find a consistent line and speed.



Birkenhead's Pennants Round-up

BNH Pennants concluded Sunday for all but one division, Men's Division 1 due to a cancelled wet day and the Centre jumping on a uncarded date, of which Riverhead objected to having already carded a club championship on that day. Birkenhead was also inconvenienced with the forced cancellation of the Club's publish Sunday Open Triples Tournament.

Of the five Birkenhead sides entered in this season's Pennants across four divisions, all but Birkenhead Wasps in the Men's Division 1 made the finals, now on last Sunday 6 November, at Manly.

In Mixed Division B Birkenhead Hives having won four rounds of the six played made the semis and came up against Warkworth. Despite a gallant effort Hives succumbed to Warkworth (8-0) and dropped out of the running, finishing third equal.

Men's Primer Birkenhead Stingers topped section 2, while in Section 1 Birkenhead Hornets finished off section play in second spot. Stingers versus Hornets in the semis with the winner progressing to the final. Stingers progressed (8-2) to face off against Orewa Premier in the final. A final that saw Orewa take out the championship honours (10-0). It is worth noting that although the total points show rather one-sided results, in reality all rounds came down to single bowls in individual games deciding the round winner. While the Men were doing battle, Birkenhead's ladies, "Bees", were also chasing Pennants glory.






