

Last Friday sports people from around North Harbour gathered for the first time in two years to celebrate what is great in North Harbour sports. Close to three hundred guests attend the elaborate evening dinner/awards at the EventFinda Stadium, formally the North Shore Event Centre

Both Birkenhead's Terry Moverley and Takapuna's Graham Dorreen were awarded "Sporting Acknowledgement Award" for their individual services to Lawn Bowls. The Birkenhead Bowling Club made the finalists of the "Club of the Year", while Birkenhead's Maureen Taylor made the finalists for "Volunteer of the Year" for her work as President of Bowls North Harbour, while Takapuna's Selina Goddard was in the running for "Sportswomen of the Year". Unfortunately, all three missed out with "Club of the Year" going to Pupuke Golf Club, "Volunteer of the Year" going to golf again John Kavanagh (Golf) and "Sportswomen of the Year" Lisa Carrington (Kayaking), there was no denying her achievements. Carrington then went on to take out the "Supreme" award for the night.

There is link on the Bowls North Harbour website where the results tables can be found and where updates are made shortly after the completion of each round.





This system was a great success and is therefore being retained for the 2022-2023. **This means:**

- Every member entering a National Event in the 2022-2023 season will need to have a profile with BowlsHub Aotearoa (If you entered a national event last season, you will already have a profile).
 - If haven't registered yet, this can be done by going to bowlshub.co.nz/signup,Once you've created an account you can log in to BowlsHub Aotearoa at www.bowlshub.co.nz (take note of your National ID/Membership number once you've logged in.)
- 2. Entering a National Event for the 2022-2023 season is done on BowlsHub Aotearoa.
- 3. Once you've logged into BowlsHub Aotearoa navigate to "My Competitions" and you will be able enter the 2023 Summerset Nationals.
- 4. If you're entering a pairs or fours event you will need to know the National ID/ Membership Number of every member in your team.
