The twelfth instalment of the ever popular two day Carpet Mill Birkenhead Men's Pairs gets underway this Saturday. Carpet Mill Archers Road returns as the tournament partner, which the Club is grateful of. Bowls New Zealand has again endorsed the tournament as part of its Summer of Sports events which sees some of the best players from the region and further afield attend.

Day one, Saturday, is all about getting in to the top sixteen for Sunday and attaining a top seeding to ease the way to the \$1,600 first prize.

With a total prize pool of in excess of \$6,000 up for grabs, a playing format enjoyed by the players and fully catered, it was little wonder the tournament filled in under a week when entries opened last September.

Round one: 2020 & 2022 champions Manurewa Cossie's David Clark and Roger Andrew return and first up against Te Atatu's Brendon Kelly and young Liam Hill from Ellerslie. Neville Hill was originally down to play with Kelly but withdrew to support his grandson and the tournament's supporters club.

Royal Oak's Martin Dixon and Mike Galloway make their return, after missing last year, taking on Pukekohe Cossie's Shaun Pennell. National titles in abundance on rink A3 as Carlton Cornwell's Wally Marsic and Petar Sain come up against recently crowned national pairs champion Birkenhead's Tony Grantham who this year has Takapuna's Jerry Belcher with him.

The boys from The Bay, Mt Maunganui's Steve Beel and Te Puke's John Gray will have their work cut out for them as they take on Birkenhead's Steve Yates and David Eades, an untried pair but both with the credentials to go far in this tournament. Birkenhead's Daymon Pierson and Jimmy Heath, aka Jandals, will be looking for a win over Mt Albert's Jamie Hill and Victoria's Mark Burgess, nephew of Birkenhead life member Keith Burgess, to kick start their campaign.

Originally the entry was under Takapuna's Garry Banks but events down in Taranaki have forced a change in the team makeup. We wish Garry Banks a successful and speedy recovery. With Garry out of bowls for a while retired sportswriter Wynne Gray has stepped in to keep fellow Takapuna club mate Dennis Hale company. Gray and Hale's first game is Birkenhead's father and son combination Peter and Chad Nathan, a nice easy game to ease into the tournament.

Round two: Logan Clark, son of David Clark, and Shane Drabble both from Manurewa Cossie tackle Tony Garelja and Billy Fulton from Henderson out in the wild west. Royal Oaks "The Gavins", Gavin Brown and James Gavin have a tough draw here up against Ellis and Hall. As does Pringle Park's Teo Turua and Royal Oak's Will Whittburn taking on Kelly and Hill. Having travelled down from the winterless north, Whangarei's Daniel Hood is without his father this trip as David has put his shoulder out. Filling in for David is Whangarei/Ellerslie Bryce Mackie. Hood and Mackie will find stiff completion against New Lynn's Adam Wishnoski and Sean Hird, although Hird has just returned from a trip home to Scotland and could be a bit out of form.

Pt Chev's Steve Hoeft has teamed up with Helensville's ever steady Bart Robertson in what is surely a pairing that will go far in this tournament, but they have firstly the dreaded rink B8 and secondly a local team in the form of Pierson and Heath to get past.

Round three: and after a legendary Birkenhead lunch, Pringle Park's Steve Gaughan and Craig Harold have stuck the dreaded rink 8 on B green against the local knowledge of Birkenhead's Robbie Church and Curtis Ennor. The only advice to the visitors is go out to play on an even number.

Either team could win and to close to call the John Hindmarch and Mike Haggart both of Birkenhead clash against Pringle Park's Andy Ellis and 2019 winner Papatoetoe Hunters Corner's Mark Hall.

The same goes for Riverhead's Steve Cox and Grant Goodwin against Royal Oak's Mike Bradshaw and Pt Chev's Kevin Morris.

A Birkenhead-Takapuna tussle awaits as Birkenhead's Gary Stevens and Gary Wallace finish their day against Gray and Hale.

The local derby of the day sees Northcote's Brent Malcolm and Greg Taylor play Yates and Eades. Traveling up the hill from Northcote Brent Malcom and Greg Taylor may need the last game against Gray and Hale, although it may be a case of one Northcote against three Takapuna as Malcom plays a large percentage of his bowls at Takapuna now days. Royal Oak's Richard Watts will be trying to ensure the trip up from the Waikato is not a wasted one for his pairs partner Frankton Junction's Alan Bowler as they take on "The

Taranaki regulars, Inglewood's Graham Reive and Steve Sabine will be a danger if there is something to play for against Hill and Burgess or it could be the social game of the day. No matter what the outcomes are on Saturday sixteen teams will move through on Sunday to play for the big money and the Champions Cup while the rest compete in the Consolation. Sunday afternoon 3pm it will be down to five finals on the top green.


