## No Singles, But Pairs

Recap from Bee Express 25 January:

Eight 1-5 Year teams headed out on the green early Saturday morning in pursuit (21 January) of Championship glory, to ultimately be decided another day after the two-life system had whittled down the field to three after the day's play.

Round one and early favourites Warren Lush and Kieran Jones made light work of Bill Robertson and Syd Walker (20-4). First years Craig Moverley and Zakk Johnson managed to pull off a win over the all-female pair of Linda Anderson and Fay Judge (11-9), While fellow first year bowlers Mark Van Echten and Daniel Smith's championship baptism was a dive into the font against last minute entrants Nick Cape and Mitch Cameron, with Cape and Cameron coming away the victors (18-8). A tight game in the Mike Pugh, Sue Thomas versus Bev Rolfe, Mark Hitchcock game with a single shot giving Rolfe/Hitchcock the win (12-11)

Round two, Cape/Cameron certainly announced their intention with and old fashion thrashing of Moverley/Johnson (20-4) to send Moverley/Johnson below the line. Rolfe/ Hitchcock also dropped below the line after receiving a thrashing themselves from Jones/ Lush (21-3), action below the line down in the one lifers section Anderson/Judge sent Van Echten/Smith home beating them by a single shot (15/14), while Robertson/Walker easily accounted for Pugh/Thomas (21-10).

Round three and the competition down to two two-lifers and four one-lifers. Cape/Cameron sent Jones/Lush below the line (15-10). While below the line itself Robertson/Walker sent Anderson/Judge home (19-12) as did Moverley/Johnson sending Rolfe/Hitchcock off (177).

Round four and the last of the day. Robertson/Walker pulled off the upset of the day, fighting from the position below the line and up against the only two lifer left, Cape/ Cameron where soundly beat (20-5) sending Cape/Cameron below the line, no two lifers left!!.

Moverley/Johnson and Jones/ Lush had everything to play for with the loser dropping out. It was Jones/Lush progressing forward with a win (13-7).

The continuation... the Final Last Saturday (25 February) saw the greens closed due to rain overnight and the soft state of the surface, so no 1-5 Year Singles Championship play

Sunday dawn a better day, with the greens open the remaining two rounds of the 1-5 Years AC Pairs were played. Three one lifers remained from the previous play date in late January. Warren Lush and Kieran Jones (s), Nick Cape and Mitch Cameron (s), Bill Robertson and Sydney Walker (s). While Robertson and Walker sat out with the bye into the final, Lush and Jones were up against Cape and Cameron for the other final spot. Lush/Jones took the early lead, up by nine

shots (9-0) after six of the fourteen ends. A lead they never relinquished with Cape/Cameron beaten (16-6) after thirteen ends.

The final Lush/Jones proved to dominant smashing Robertson/Walker (21-1) with Walker waving the white flag after twelve ends. Warren Lush and Kieran Jones were declared the Birkenhead 1-5 Year AC Pairs Champions for 2022-23.

## **Bowling Fan's Naked Dash Over in Flash**

It wasn't just bowling balls that spectators saw at the National Fours bowling tournament in Alexandra on Saturday, when a streaker dashed across the green during play.

Raelene Kavanagh (71) was sitting with a group of fellow women bowlers when the unexpected happened. A streaker appeared from the side of the clubhouse, ran across the bowling green and disappeared back behind the clubhouse.

"Everyone roared," Ms Kavanagh said.

"It was funny ... All you saw was bottom."

The incident, which is believed to be a first for bowls, happened at Alexandra Bowling Club during the afternoon livestream of the tournament.

Club manager Paul Jerrom also witnessed the nimble nude. It was a warm day, but you would not have known by looking at him, Mr Jerrom said.

"A world first in Alexandra," he added.
The streaker was believed to be a spectator connected to a team that had been knocked out of the competition the previous day. The disturbance was a sign bowls was joining mainstream sport, Mr Jerrom said. The crowd seemed to enjoy the spectacle. "I don't think anyone was outraged."

He thought bowlers might expect him to organise a repeat performance for the mixed pairs. "Once was enough," Ms Kavanagh said.

The match was being broadcast on Sky Sport 600 and New Zealand Bowls' YouTube

Tournament director Chris Lander, of Wairarapa, preferred to talk about the competition. "It was a very good day of bowls," Mr Lander said.

Police said they had not been made aware of the incident.

The National Fours tournament finished on Sunday.
