



Nagy Strikes Gold

New Zealand's Men's Fours (Mike Nagy, Mike Kernaghan, Blake Signal, Ali Forsyth(s)) showed their dominance of the fours discipline throughout the week with 26-10, 13-9, 25-5, 20-8, 45-4, 29-8, 36-4 and 23-17 wins during section play to top the section and move straight to the semi final where they came up against Scotland with two times Glasgow gold medallist Alex Marshall skipping. Continuing the momentum from section play New

Zealand dispatched Scotland 20-3. While on the other side of the draw Australia beat Ireland 22-10 to progress through to a Trans-Tasman final. After three ends of the final Australia led 3 -2, but that's where Australia stopped with New Zealand picking up a four on the next end and moving out to a 13-3 lead after eight ends. The Aussies picked up a one on end nine and from there on it was all one way traffic in New Zealand's favour, shaking hands on end fifteen with New Zealand ahead 23-4 and the world championship title and gold

medal secured. Birkenhead's Mike Nagy comes away from two weeks of world championship bowls with a bronze in the Men's triples and a gold in the Men's Fours, well done Mike and the rest of the New Zealand Men's Fours team.

To add the icing on the cake Shannon McIlroy claimed the gold in the Men's singles championship, beating Canadian Ryan Bester 21-17 in the final on Sunday afternoon. The New Zealand men's squad with their medal haul of gold in the singles and fours, bronze in the pairs and triples also claimed the Leonard Trophy for the top men's squad.
