# \$6,500 Women's Invitation Pairs

In June 2009 under the Presidency of Rod Mahon the men of Birkenhead voted to allow women full membership of the club. Emmie Swart and Leanne Chinery set out to put Birkenhead on the map of women's bowls and announce that the women had arrived. Thus the Women's Open Pairs Tournament with its big money and high class was born. The initial tournament, organised in a short period of time, with prize money of \$4,300, was an overwhelming success. In 2013 and in its fourth year with "Slipp Inn" sponsoring for the third consecutive year and prize money was \$6,500. 2014 the tournament reached its fifth year and to celebrate the prize money was raised to \$7,000. 2015 and 2016 saw the tournament full early again with a number of teams in reserve. 2017 the weather intervened and unlike 2013 the 2017 tournament was forced to be abandoned.

2018 and Sunday 17 and Sunday 18 March the \$6,500 Women's Invitation Pairs will be played out on the greens at Birkenhead with a top prize of \$1,500. We are again grateful for the continued support from "The Good Home Birkenhead".



# **Copper Penny Salad**

Leanne Chinery introduced the Club to the South African Copper Penny Salad and it has become a firm favourite with those that have discovered it, just ask Bub Pike and John Ennor to name a few.

#### Ingredients

- 1 kilogram carrots, sliced
- 1 stalk celery, chopped
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 x 420 gram can condensed tomato soup
- 1/3 cup vegetable oil
- 1/2 cup distilled white vinegar
- 2/3 cup white sugar

#### Directions

- Bring a pot of water to boil, add carrots and boil until the carrots are just tender, approximately 10 minutes. Drain well.
- In a mixing bowl combine the celery, green pepper, carrots and onion.
- 3. Bring tomato soup, oil, vinegar and sugar to a boil. Stir well. Remove the mixture from the heat and let cool, 10 to 15 minutes. Pour the mixture over the vegetables, mix until all of the vegetables are coated. Marinate this salad overnight before serving.
