Defence Begins Thursday

Tomorrow, Birkenhead begins their defence of the PPL title (Power Play Pairs League) they won last season. Thursday evening Birkenhead hosts Zone Four (Birkenhead, Beach Haven, Northcote and Glenfield) with two rounds to be played. Round one sees Birkenhead up against Beach Haven, while round two Birkenhead takes on Glenfield. Play commences as soon as all players are available but no later than 6pm. Sides consist of six players of any combination playing in three teams of two bowl pairs and two sets of five ends. Each team can allocate one end per set as a power play end whereby they score double points for any shots scored.

At the conclusion of play a BBQ is provided for all players competing that night and in the Birkenhead way we will also endeavour to feed those club supporters.

The top team in each zone will be found at the conclusion of the four weeks of qualifying whereby each team in a zone plays every other team in the zone twice. With the top team proceeding to the finals day the afternoon Saturday 27th October.
