It Just Keeps Taking

The summer has not got off to a good start; in fact it hasn't started at all with not a single bowl being played since mid-March. Ardern has announced Auckland will be staying in Alert Level 2.5 until at least 11.59pm Wednesday 16 September. Covid has taken the Club's first two open tournaments for the summer with Sunday Triples 13 September and Wednesday Triples 16 September both cancelled. The current restrictions have forced the rescheduling, for the fourth time Prize-giving 2019-20 to 6.30pm Friday 2 October. While the rescheduled Opening day is set down for the following day Saturday 3 October, with the formal part of the day starting at 4pm. The traditional Opening Day roll-up or in recent years mini tournament has been replaced with the Allan Meekings (Any Combination, Drawn, Single-entry) starting at the early time of 9am and finishing by 3pm, in plenty of time for the Official Opening at 4pm.

Contact Tracing Under Alert Level 2

It is now mandatory for businesses including clubs to display the NZ COVID Tracer App QR Code for contact tracing purposes. The rules for contact tracing have changed slightly since May and there has been a little confusion around the requirements.

The current COVID-19 Public Health Response (Alert Levels 3 and 2) Order 2020 requires businesses to:

- display a copy of the QR code for the business or service in a prominent place at or near the main entrances to the workplace; and
- have other systems and processes in place to support contact tracing of persons who enter the workplace or carry out work for the business or service;

Those other systems and processes are mainly focused on having a manual solution for people who do not have a smart phone or the NZ COVID Tracer App.

All those entering the Birkenhead Bowling Club premise are

to use the NZ COVID Tracer App QR code or complete the manual contact tracing form, this applies to everyone, no exceptions, club entrances are covered by CCTV for the safety of all our members.




